

2021 Vendor Policies & Procedures

The **4th Annual Collard Green Festival** will be held Saturday, **March 6, 2021 from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm** at the Evergreen Airport.

Guidelines:

- 1. NO VENDORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO SELL OR GIVE AWAY DRINKS OF ANY KIND!!
- 2. Politicians, Organizations, Clubs, Churches will not be allowed to give away food or drinks or any other items that will be in conflict with any registered vendor selling the same
- 3. Vendors can begin setting up at 12pm Friday, March 5th, however the Chamber of Commerce and festival organizers cannot be responsible for items left out overnight unattended.
- 4. All vendors must be unloaded and have their vehicle out of the vendor area no later than 7:30 am Saturday. No vehicles will be allowed to exit or enter the vendor area after 7:30 am.
- 5. All vendors must be completely set up by 9:00 am.
- 6. All vendors must provide their own tents, chairs, extension cords, tables, etc.
- 7. All vendors MUST REMAIN SET UP UNTIL 5PM SATURDAY for the safety of our festival goers.

Application Information:

- 1. Booth fees are \$30 for each 12X12 space without electricity, and \$50 if you require electricity. Each Food Vendor space is \$75 and has water and electricity. Powered booths are limited, so we ask that you get electricity only if your craft requires it.
- 2. We will accept applications up to Wednesday March 3rd, 2021
- 3. Deadline for refunds is Friday, February 12th.

Fees: \$30 per 12X12 spaces without electricity

\$50 per 12X12 spaces with electricity

\$75 per 12X12 spaces for Food Vendors (includes electricity and water) There will be a maximum of 6 Food Vendors and we would have to have your application and fee paid in order to reserve your spot.
